## **IMPORTANT!**

IMPLEMENTATION OF CO-MO CONNECT FIBER OPTIC SERVICE HAS STARTED.

**You must sign up now.** CO-MO's fiber optic trial in Laurie and Sunrise beach is completed and exceeded expectations. Service is being expanded to all of the CO-MO service areas and we are scheduled first with construction starting in early 2013.

CO-MO Electric's will implement the latest "state of the art" fiber optic service with broadband internet, telephone, and HDTV capabilities. We believe that not only will service to our properties be dramatically improved, there will also be a positive impact on property values and ease of resale.

There will finally be true broadband for Porto Cima.

- CO-MO's trial areas have provided enhanced service at a lower cost.
- Technical support will be local.
- The RAIN/SNOW FADE associated with satellite TV will be eliminated.

We encourage you to consider ordering CO-MO Connect. They require 20% of the residents to sign in advance and the areas with the highest rates will be first. All Town Home properties are located in the first phase. **It is important to order now.**

- You do not have to order all three services. [Internet, Telephone, HDTV] Pick any 2 services, take **\$15 off** your monthly bill. Pick all 3 services; take **\$35 off** your monthly bill.
- In most situations you can keep your present phone number, assuming you want telephone service.
- HDTV packages are available in various channel combinations, with and without a DVR.
- **There is a "Seasonal Rate" plan for absence during winter months.**
- CO-MO pricing, in most situations, appears less expensive than combinations of service from other providers. In one calculation, a competitor's bundle plan priced at \$150 priced out at \$115 for comparable features using state of the art Fiber Optic service from CO-MO Connect.

CO-MO started taking applications for service the week of December 10<sup>th</sup>. **You do not need to pick exactly what service you want to fill out an application.** You will only need to state that you want to be connected.
