

Street Maintenance, Street Lighting and Sewers

All streets within the geographic area of the Porto Cima Townhouse Property Owners Association (PCTPOA) are the responsibility of the Four Seasons Lakesites Property Owners Association (FSLPOA) or Camden County. Each member of the PCTPOA also belongs FSLPOA and pays fees annually to that organization to maintain and operate our streets, streetlights, and the sewage system. Individual Grinder Pumps and other interior components of the sewage system are the responsibility of the individual owner.

Main throughfares connecting the streets within the PCTPOA to the greater County and State Road system are the responsibility of the Camden County Road and Bridge Department.
